



Project Title: Intercultural Understanding: A Transformative Student Training Model

The University of British Columbia is committed to building an inclusive living and learning environment in which all students can thrive and where students graduate with the knowledge and skills to actively contribute to a civil and sustainable society. Drawing on the draft Intercultural Understanding Strategic plan and the "Active Witness Model" developed by Dr. Ishu Ishiyama (2000), the second year of this TLEF funded project looks to expand, enhance and strengthen the work that was laid out in the project's first year of funding. With a focus on the evaluation of this approach and on building a strong community of practice for student leaders we will engage an additional 60 student leaders in a peer-training model who will in turn engage 250 student organizations and/or communities on campus and expand our passive campaign to enhance our capacity to reach more people across campus.
